Daughter of the Reformation

Many books have been written about the great Reformer Martin Luther, but we know considerably less about his wife Catharina von Bora, the primary relationship in his life. Mary Rasmussen Jackson tells dramatic story with Catharina's authenticity and compassion, deftly reporting what we know about von Bora and filling in the missing content with imagination, clarity, and compelling dialog. The reader is invited to walk beside Catharina. listen to her thoughts, and feel her emotions as she enters eventually flees from the Nimschen Convent, meets and marries Martin Luther, and brings stability grace to the Luther household even as the Reformation storm rages

around them. The author writes with intelliaible style that sometimes descriptive and other times evocative. She brings to the project the authenticity of one who grew up in a parsonage experienced firsthand the rhythms of the parish that shape the flow of family life and relationships. For all of these reasons, this book will be helpful in deepening understanding of the role Catharina von Bora. 


